Students may use the computers in the Go Center to register for the SAT/ACT, NCAA, NAIA and college applications. The college advisor is in the Go Center to help you.


A Scholarship File Cabinet is located in the Go Center with paper copies of scholarships not posted on the internet and sent to the school.
